Randy and Diana Smyth of Ethnos360 are passionate for building teams to plant thriving churches where Christ is not known. **Ethnos360**, formerly known as New Tribes Mission, works among people groups there is no church, nor is there any work being done to establish a church.



Following years of training, Randy joined the **New Tribes Mission Aviation** team in 1992 and began work as a bush pilot in Papua New Guinea in 1994. He was raised on the island of Borneo in Indonesia among Dayak tribes. As a teenager Randy helped to pioneer missionary work among the Urun Da'an people, who had been headhunters. While traveling treacherous rivers and hiking jungle trails, God put it on his heart to help speed the message of eternal life through Jesus Christ to remote language groups using aircraft. He has over 6,000 hours of flying time; most of them using a Cessna 206 in Papua

New Guinea as a missionary bush pilot. Randy's real passion is sharing the message of God's grace with people who have not heard. He enjoys declaring the glory of the God who is worthy of all praise. He loves promoting Firm Foundations tools for communicating a clear Gospel message and a solid foundation for faith in Christ alone. He enjoys encouraging God's people toward actively reaching out to the unreached language groups of the world.



Diana came into Randy's life in 2001 after years of working as a missionary for Cru and later as the corporate computer trainer for Mercedes-Benz USA. They were married in 2002 and together have



served in Papua New Guinea since 2003. Diana has worked as Flight Follower and computer consultant; tracking aircraft, relaying messages, coordinating communications, developing software systems and coaching missionaries on computer use. She loves to share with women about how the extraordinary God has used ordinary people to bring about marvelously good transformations for His glory.

Believing that faith comes by hearing the Word of God which is spoken by messengers who are sent, Randy & Diana Smyth now work to encourage churches and potential missionaries. More than 100 people groups have requested to hear about God in their own language but there are not yet enough Christians who are willing invest the time to tell them. Living in New England, the Smyths travel to help people learn about missions and assist churches with sending missionaries to Unreached People Groups through New Tribes Mission.
